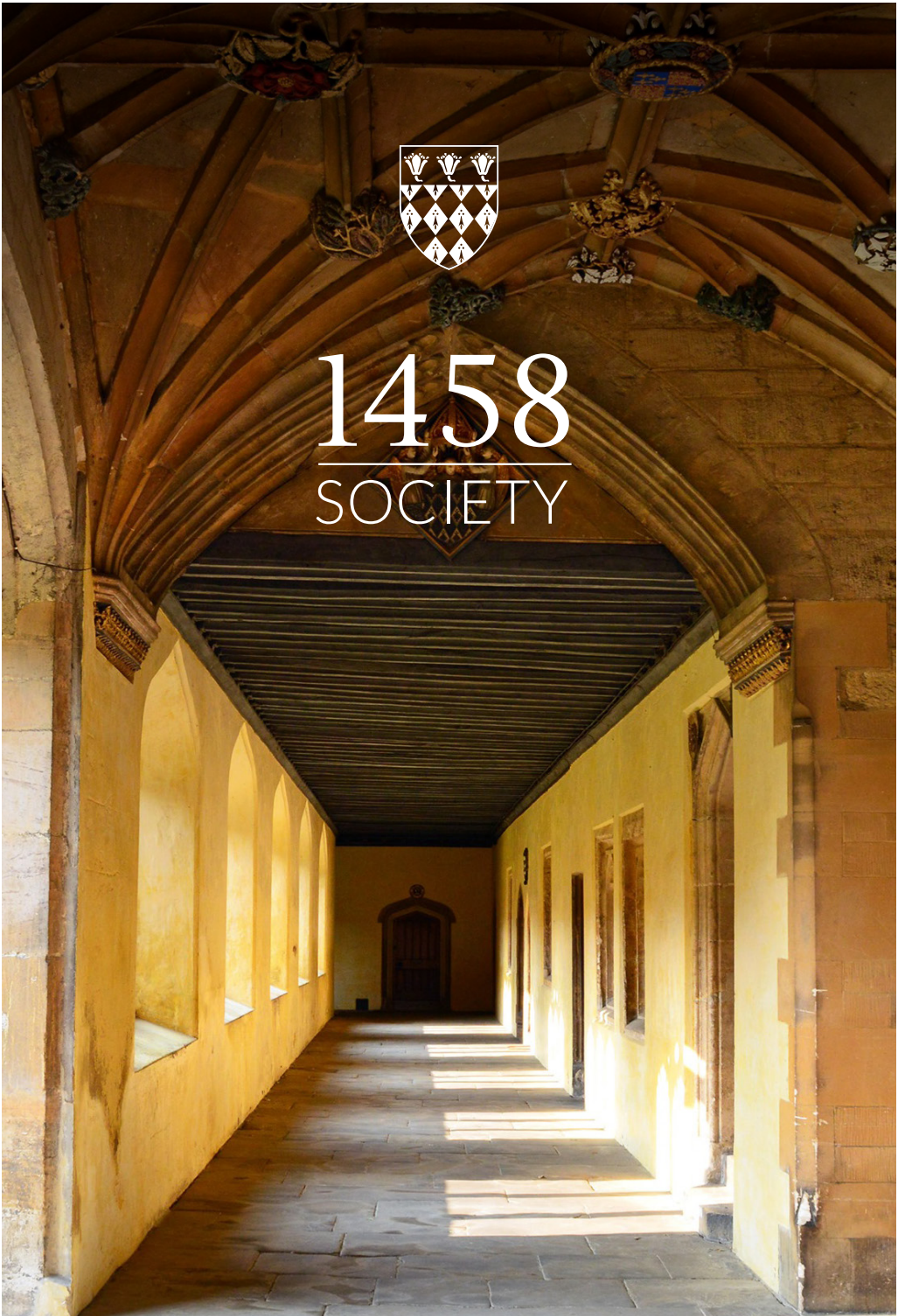

## Impact of the 1458 Society

1458 Society members make a significant difference to Magdalen's ability to deliver its strategic priorities each year, particularly those that rely on steady and predictable income streams. Current College priorities include:

### Access and Outreach

One of Magdalen's key priorities is to encourage the brightest students from all backgrounds to apply to Oxford and give them the information they need to make a competitive application.

A gift to our Access and Outreach programme will help us to support applications from the broadest possible pool of prospective students who have the potential to benefit from and contribute to the extraordinary opportunities on offer here.

### Graduate Scholarships

Our graduate students come from all over the globe to study at Magdalen due to Oxford University's reputation as a global research powerhouse, and are some of the brightest minds in the world. They have a considerable impact on the intellectual life of Magdalen, as well as the wider academic community. However, each year a large number of the best candidates have to decline their offer of a place at Magdalen due to a lack of financial means.

A gift to Graduate Scholarships will help us provide funding for graduate students to ensure that talented candidates are not lost to other institutions or abandon postgraduate study altogether.

## Student Opportunity Fund

What makes Magdalen special is the breadth of opportunities available here, in addition to academic study. We want to encourage students to enrich their Magdalen experience by contributing to the cultural life of the College.

A gift to the Student Opportunity Fund, in memory of former President Tony Smith, will ensure that every student can afford to explore a wide range of interests, from music, art, drama and sports, to entrepreneurial opportunities and internships.

## Tax-efficient giving examples

Your Gift	Value to College with Gift Aid	Actual cost to 40% taxpayer	Actual cost to 45% taxpayer
£1,458	£1,823	£1,094	£1,002
£5,000	£6,250	£3,750	£3,437
£10,000	£12,500	£7,500	£6,875

If you are a UK taxpayer, you can increase the value of your donation by 25%. If you are a higher-rate taxpayer, you can also claim the difference between your tax rate and the basic rate of tax on your charitable donation.
