VACATION STUDY GRANTS 2025-2026

Grants of £16.39 per night are available to **all current undergraduates** for essential academic work in Oxford during the vacation. Those living out of College in Oxford are also eligible.

Grants are not available for students who have intermitted their studies, or who are returning for re-sit examinations. No internship or work experience may be funded by this grant.

The following **annual entitlement** for each undergraduate runs from 1 August each year:

- 30 nights for students taking FHS examinations (including students taking FHS examinations in the second, third or fourth year),
- 15 nights for those taking Prelims, Moderations, or Honour Moderations, or compulsory vacation courses, and
- 10 nights for others.

You can claim for the nights up to and including the night of your last examination held during the vacation.

PROCEDURE

Please read the APPLICATION and CLAIM instructions carefully. You must send an **application form** by noon on the Friday of Week 6 in the term preceding your residence **followed by a claim form** no later than noon on the Friday of Week 1 in the term after your residence in order to obtain the Vacation Study Grant.

No late or retrospective applications will be considered, unless in exceptional circumstances.

APPLICATION

The application form should be completed and passed to a Magdalen Tutorial Fellow or Stipendiary Lecturer to obtain their approval. The tutor must sign the form and state in which category the application falls. The completed application form should then be returned electronically to the Tutorial Administrators (tutorial.administrator@magd.ox.ac.uk) **no later than noon of Friday of Week 6 of the term preceding vacation residence.**

Applicants will receive email confirmation from the Tutorial Administrators of approval in principle of grant applications, with a **claim form** attachment.

NB: Those requiring College accommodation must apply separately to the Accommodation Office using their vacation residence form. DO NOT send the Vacation Study Grant application to the Accommodation Office: it may delay the application and jeopardise the claim.

CLAIM

In order to receive a Vacation Study Grant a student **must** complete a claim form that will have been sent to the applicant by the Tutorial Administrators. The claim form must be submitted after the residence is complete and **no later than noon on Friday of Week 1 of the term after the vacation concerned** to tutorial.administrator@magd.ox.ac.uk.

Vacation study grants are paid directly into students' bank accounts later that term.
